Suckler Herd Fertility

The aim of efficient suckled calf production can be defined as achieving the maximum output (kg) of saleable beef per breeding cow per year. Studies show that spring-calving herds in England produced 88 calves per 100 cows or heifers put to the bull in 2018. Compared with a target of 94, this shows there is room for improvement.

Managing and improving the fertility of your suckler herd is one of the key ways to improve cow margins and hence business profitability. This Zoom meeting is designed to help you assess your herd's fertility and identify scope for improvement. It will hopefully provide ideas you can put into practice on your farm.
